Prerequisites

- ● Be at least 16 years old
- ● Be certified as an IKO kiteboarder level 3 for at least 6 months
- ● Have a powerboat license or equivalent skill level if no obligatory license is required in the home country
- ● Have a valid first aid certificate

- ● Be at least 18 years old
- ● Kiteboard for more than 6 months and be able to perform a jump, a controlled turn, switch riding, and be able to ride between other riders
- ● Have an IKO assistant instructor certification or justify a teaching experience in a water or aerial sport
- ● Have a valid first aid certificate
- ● Have a powerboat license or equivalent skill level if no obligatory license is required in the home country

- ● Be an IKO instructor level 1
- ● teach 160 hours to minimum 20 students and maximum 30 students

- ● Be an instructor level 2
- ● teach + 840 hours (1000 hours in total) and minimum +100 students (120 in total).

- ● Be an instructor level 2 senior and have at least 2 years of teaching experience
- ● Have taught to students in different locations
- ● Be fluent English and preferably another language
- ● Be at least 25 years old.
